Dear Mark,

Carlisle Contractors, Inc. has been in the heavy construction and waste hauling business for over 30 years. As anyone in the business of waste hauling and landfill operations knows, flat tires and slow leaks are an everyday occurrence. Over the years we have been approached by numerous products claiming to eliminate flat tires. Needless to say, we were very skeptical when we were approached by your representative, Rick McGee. After reviewing your lab reports and talking with some of your other customers, we decided to give Ride-On a try.


We started by testing your product in our John Deere model 9400 tractor. Before using your product, we had to air up three times a day (15-20 minutes downtime per airing). We average about \$1200.00/hr (gross revenue) with this tractor; so, any downtime is very costly. Since pumping your product in the tires, we have gone more than 3 weeks without needing to re-air. Therefore, a quick calculation shows that we have saved \$13,500.00 in gross revenue in just three weeks. We had similar results with our CAT Pan. A flat tire on this equipment costs us half a day at a cost of \$400/hr. It is almost too good to express!

We now have Ride-On in all our trucks and trailers. We have reduced the number of flat tires from as many as 14 a week to one or two, in the last 6 weeks. We estimate that the reduction of flat tires alone will save our company as much as 100,000.00 per year. Wow!

Your product works! Flat tires and down time are no longer an everyday part of our business.
